## 1. Introduction

Majority of the AMCs of member states applying FUA assumed full control over the continuous update of all kinds of restrictions with effect on IFPS flight plan trajectory validation through the rolling AUP/UUP process using the mechanism of RSA allocation and activation of FUA restriction(s) associated to it. Therefore, the number of NOTAMs announcing closures of CDR and/or ATS routes decreased dramatically in the past 5 years. Despite that due to legacy procedures defined in national AIP publications, some member states continue publishing ATS/CDR route closures by NOTAM.

The AMCs of the following member states will always promulgate all the necessary flight planning (FUA) restrictions via AUP/UUP (including route segment closures, if needed): Austria, Bulgaria, Bosnia and Herzegovina, Cyprus, Czech Republic, Denmark, Estonia, Germany, Greece, Netherlands, Norway, Poland, Portugal, Romania, Serbia and Slovenia.

**Albania, Italy and Malta** are publishing NOTAMs to announce route unavailability, but as the AMCs are not officially part of the national approval/coordination process, there is no full guarantee that every announced closure will be promulgated through the rolling AUP/UUP process. **⋉** 

**Switzerland** is publishing NOTAMs to announce ATS and/or CDR route unavailability. All CDR route segment closures are promulgated through the rolling AUP/UUP process. 

★

Belgium, Croatia, Finland, France, Latvia, Slovakia, Spain, Sweden and United Kingdom/Ireland are not publishing NOTAMs to announce route availability as a standard procedure. Whenever such NOTAM is published, there is high probability that national AMCs are not involved in the coordination/approval process and that data will never be promulgated via the rolling AUP/UUP process.

**Ukraine** is in crisis situation and all FIRs are unavailable. When the normal operations will resume, route closure/unavailability NOTAMs will be processed as shown under paragraph 2 below. <mark>
